Using natural materials, such as wood and rock, the house seems to blend with the surroundings, despite its unusual shape and dimensions. For the main vertical communication, the plank balances on a large rock like structure that keeps the idea grounded. With large open halls and wide atrium spaces, the interior of the house seems to blend with the outside world. With low ceiling height and wide panoramic windows, the outside world seems to flow into the every space of the house.
